We would like to introduce you to Indiana Bass'n Gals, the state's oldest and largest "all" women's fishing club. Indiana Bass'n Gals is a very active club in and around central Indiana communities, and is based out of Indianapolis. We have an active roster of seventeen women and national affiliation with the Woman's Bass Fishing Association. IBG has many goals and projects that we consider worthwhile endeavors.

We have actively raised money for the Children's Wish Foundation, Downs Syndrome Research and Indiana's Dept. of Natural Resources' Program, "Turn in a Poacher". We have raised funds to improve the state's largemouth bass broodstock through genetic testing in conjunction with IUPUI. We have refurbished equipment and facilities at Lake Monroe, in addition to teaching various seminars to the Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, and Jake's Day, a fishing/outdoorsmen kids' day. We hosted the Indiana Bass Federation-Western Division Top Eight Tournament held at Patoka Lake, not to mention many other projects here in the State of Indiana. This year, we have organized 2 spring open team tournaments to be held at Lake Monroe and Patoka Lake, two of the most popular bass lakes in Indiana. We expect 50-70 teams to participate in each tourney. We will have a team of our top four anglers plus alternate going to the WBFA national Affiliate Club Championship (ACC) this spring. We also are very proud to host the 19th annual Kid & Co. Tournament in August. This is a bass/panfish tournament for kids 6-17 in which 125 participated last summer.

The reason we are so successful is due to wonderful sponsors who have helped us in various ways. Their donations of time, money, product, or publicity have enabled us to achieve the completion of our projects. We are a not-for-profit organization; therefore, our means and budgets are limited.
